CRITERIA FOR RESIDENCY

ADMISSION:

Resident(s) must be 50 years of age or older and a member of the Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe or other federally recognized Indian Tribe and must demonstrate ability to pay. The resident must have an Annual Physical form filled out by their primary care provider not more than 90 days old prior to admission. Residents must see a physician at least annually thereafter and have the annual physical form completed by their physician. Residents must have a two-step mantoux (TB test) within 3 days of admission unless one was completed within 6 months. Any resident with documentable, recurring positive mantoux tests in the past must see their physician and have a chest x-ray. The physician will need to document that the resident is free from infectious diseases.

ASSESSMENTS:

The Resident Care Manager will do an assessment of the residents' needs prior to admission using a pre-admission screening tool. Assessments are to be completed no more than 2 weeks prior to move in. Out of state moves will be required to submit a complete, current and accurate medical history and physical report from their primary care provider. An assessment will be done upon admission. Continued assessments will be done as needed.
