ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 14-<u>002</u>

ORDER REGARDING CIVIL JUDGMENTS AND JUDGMENTS OF FULL FAITH AND CREDIT

Effective immediately, Tribal Court will be implementing the following process to enforce civil and foreign money judgments.

The petitioning, service and scheduling procedures will remain in effect. The civil judgment procedure will now involve granting the judgment without designation of how the plaintiff collects the funds (unless specifically agreed to by plaintiff and defendant).

The plaintiff may petition the court for a Writ of Garnishment after 21 days of the date of judgment. The Writ of Garnishment allows plaintiff to request a withholding from percapita or payroll. There will be a \$20 filing fee associated with filing a Writ of Garnishment. If granted, the percapita/payroll departments will remit the funds directly to plaintiff or their designee. This will no longer be a court function.

The court will keep files open for 60 days after judgment. If the plaintiff does not file within 60 days, the file will close and the plaintiff may be charged a motion fee if they wish to reopen and seek garnishment.

Plaintiff may seek garnishment for the amount of the judgment only.
